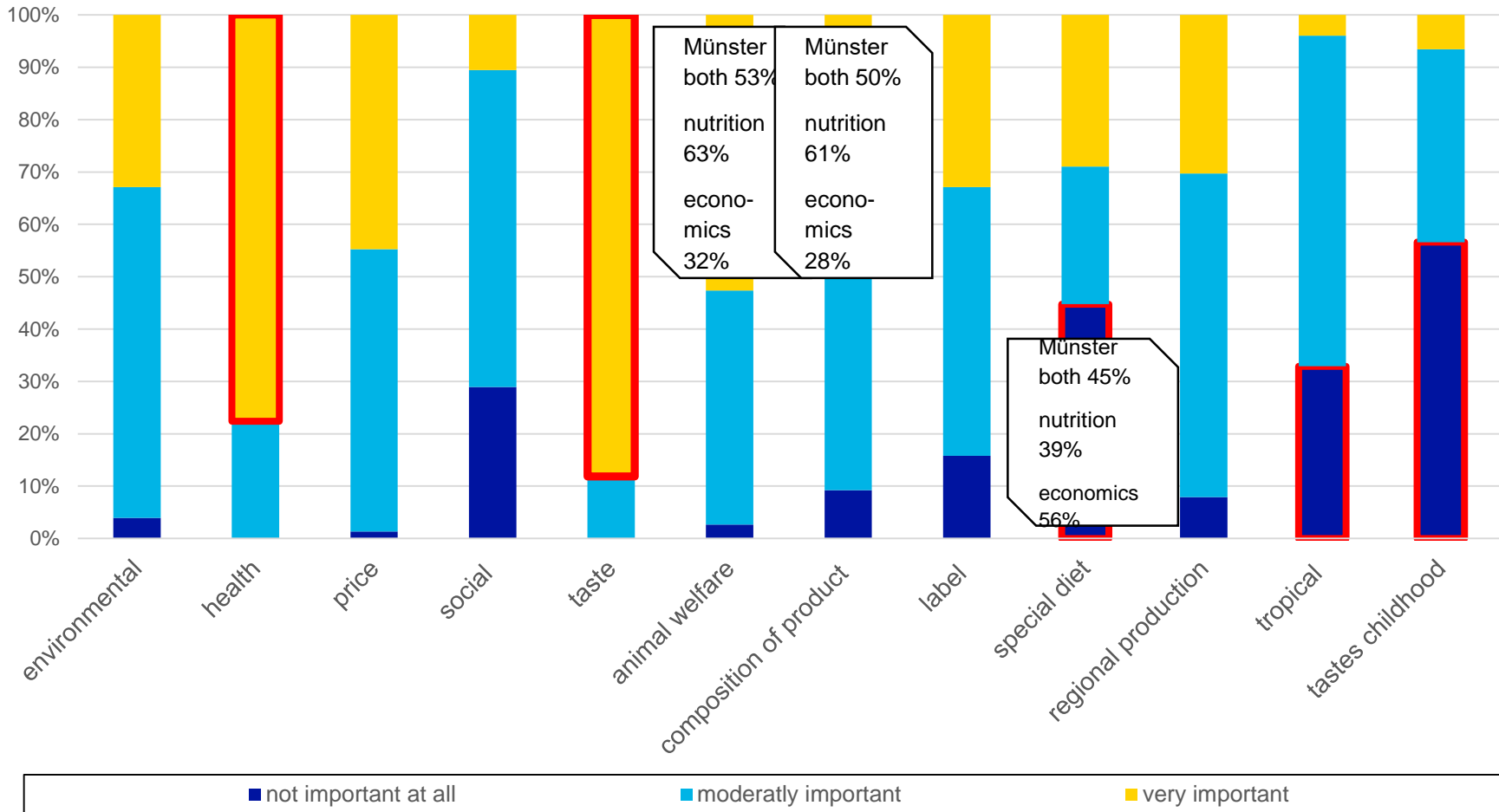

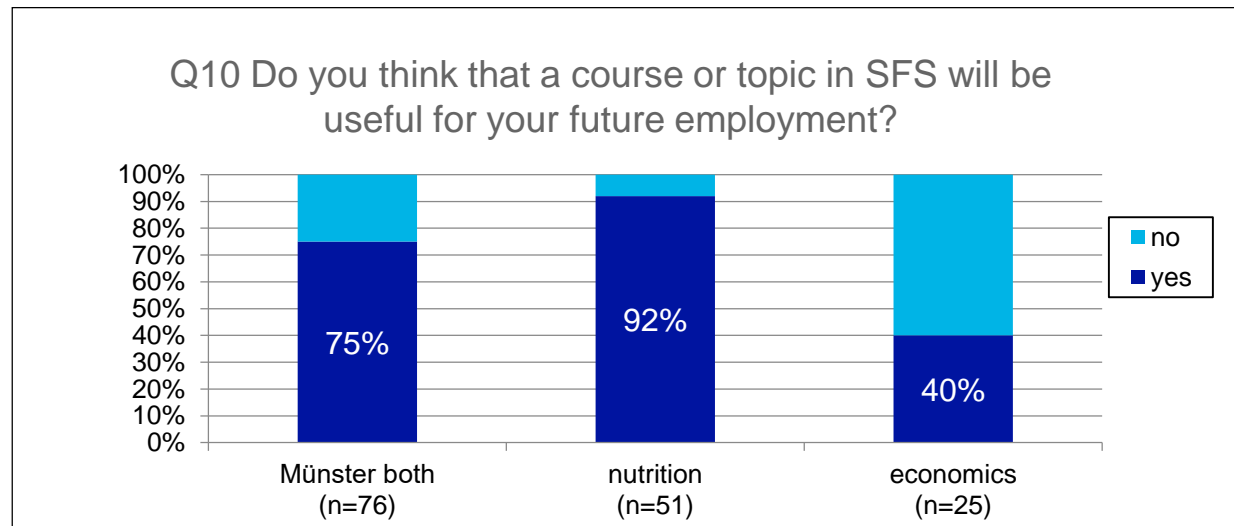
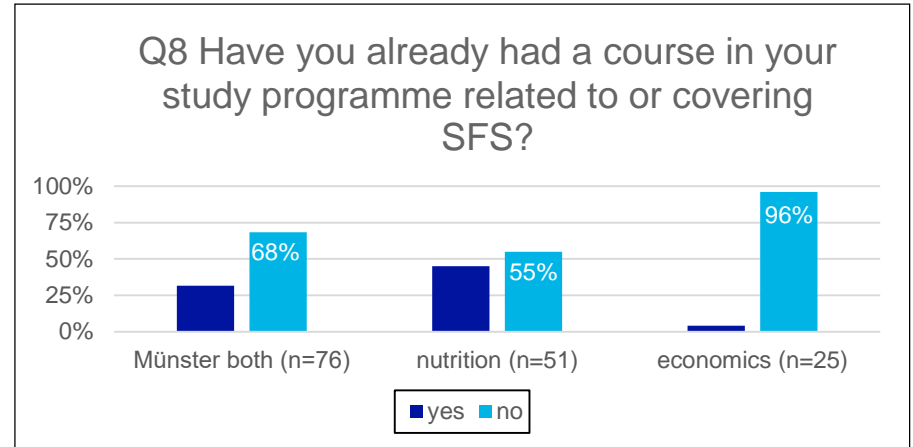
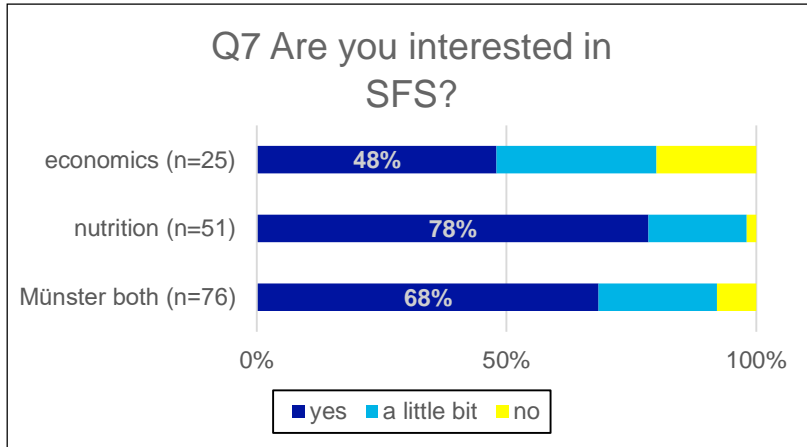

Q1 How important are the motives of your buying / consuming decisions? *Cohort Münster both (n=76)*



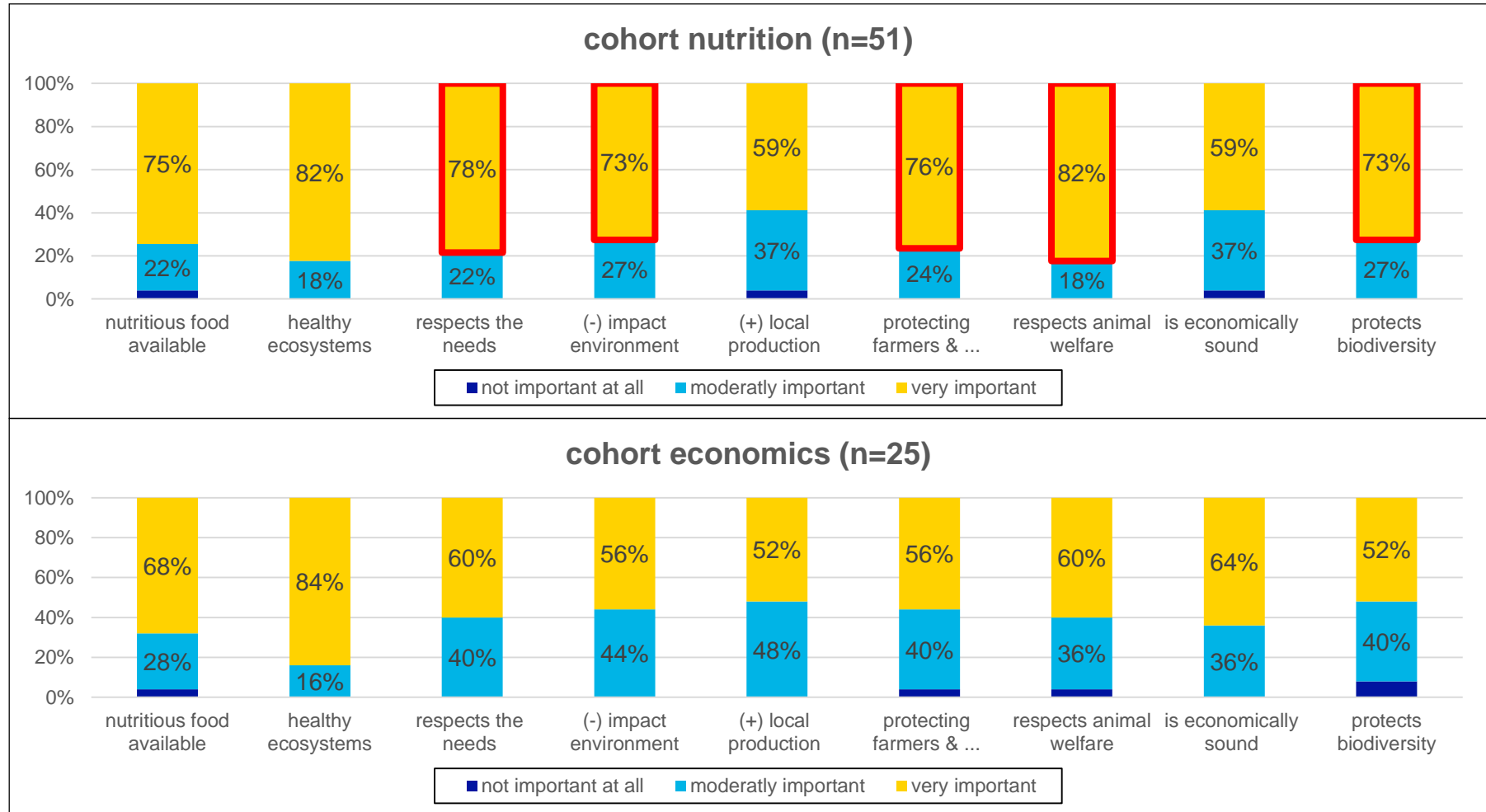

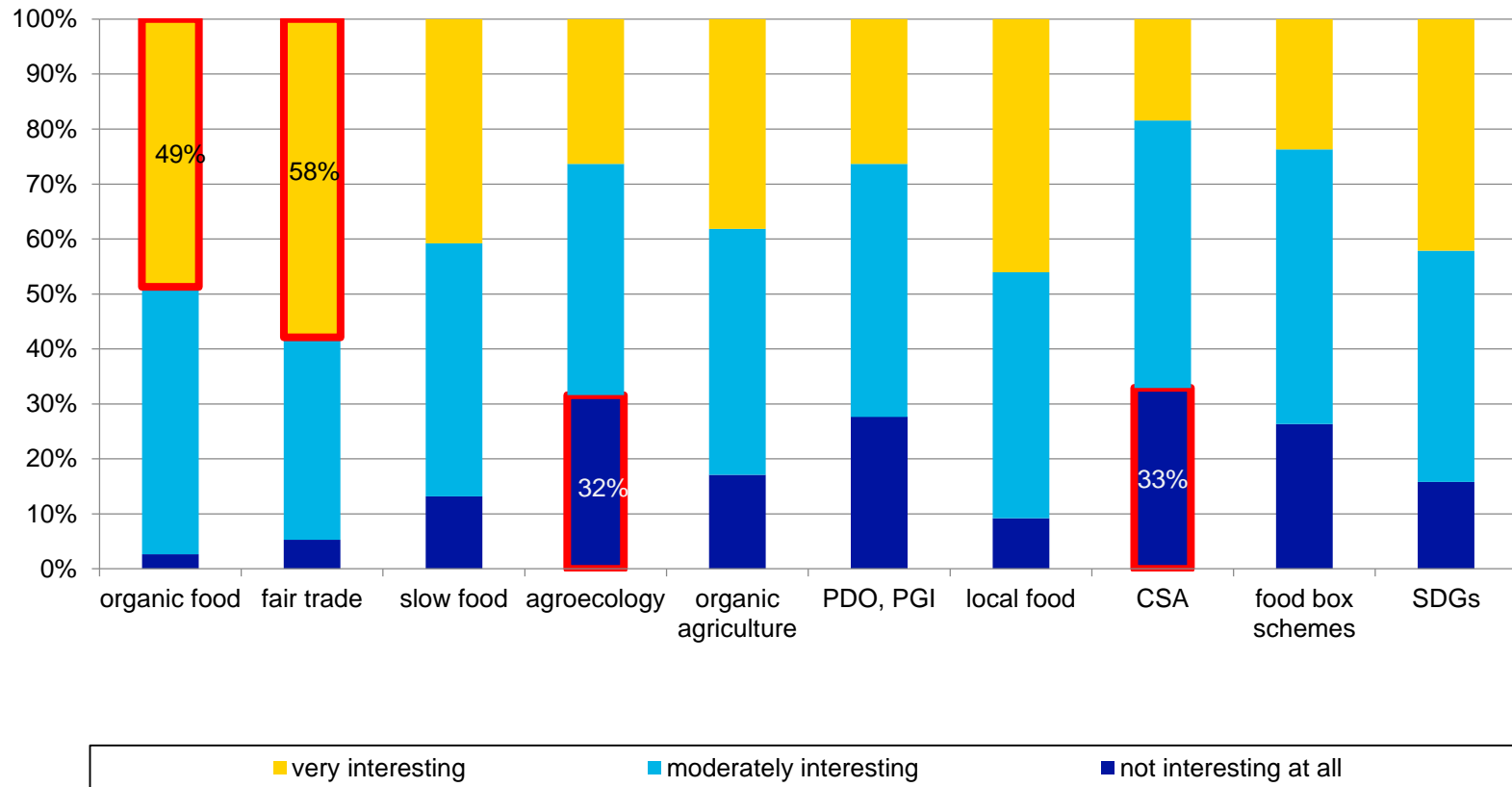

Q6 In your opinion, how important are the following elements of a SFS?



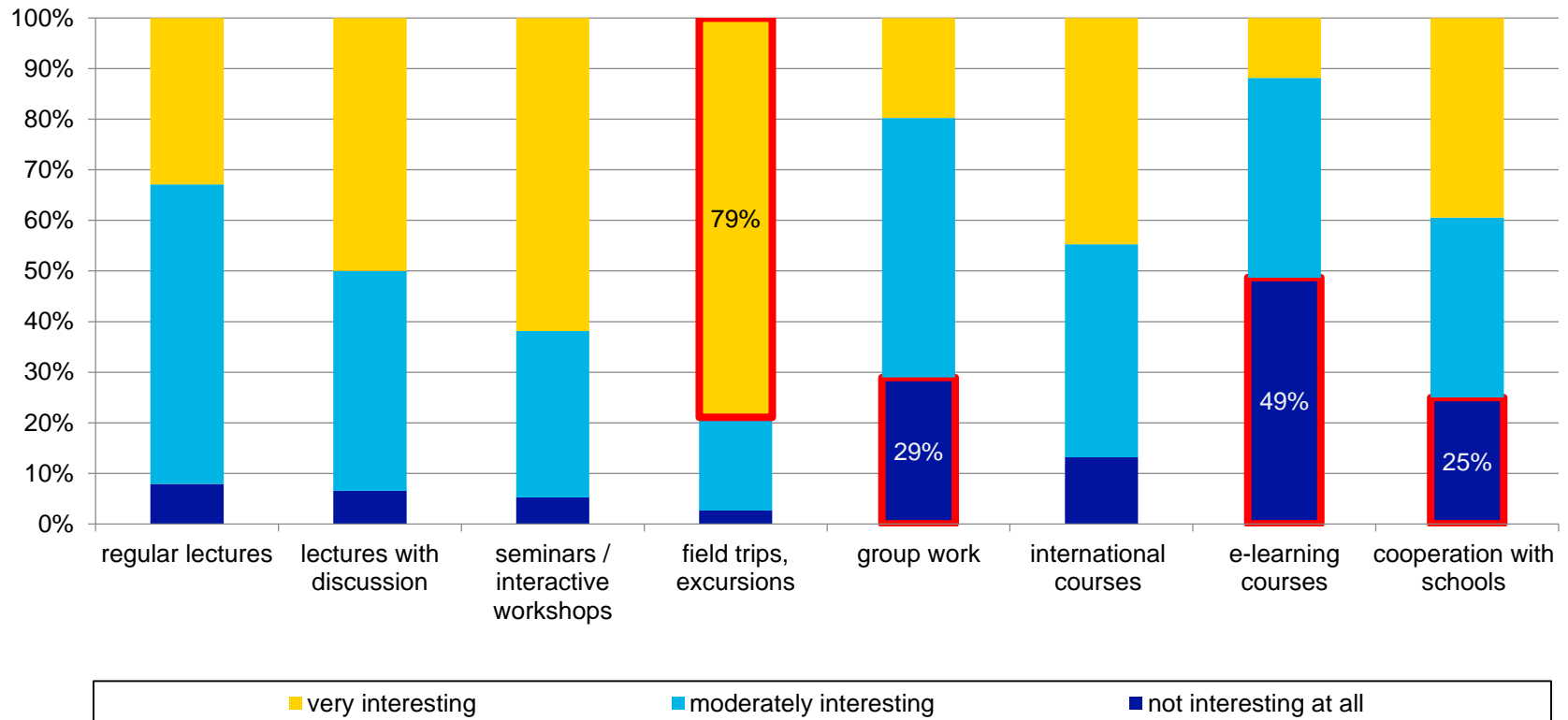

Conclusion

Q1: the students seem to consider aspects of a SFS subconsciously/intuitively, Especially the students of nutrition, who already have an affinity for food and health. Maybe the students of economics would need to be addressed differently to change their consuming decisions.

Q7,8,10: although they didn't hear much about SFS in university (especially the students of economics) both cohorts are interested in the topic.

Q11: the contents of the summer school should be adapted to the interests of all the students by comparing the results of all partners.

Q14: regarding to the summer school the interests and wishes of the students should be taken into consideration for the further planning about the methods.
